# The Indwelling Spirit

1

1 John 4:13

The Spirit's presence confirms our abiding in God. It's a divine gift, not human achievement.

Ephesians 1:13-14

The Spirit seals believers, guaranteeing their inheritance. inheritance. It's a divine down payment on salvation. salvation.

Galatians 4:6

God sends the Spirit of His Son into believers' hearts. It's hearts. It's an intimate, familial indwelling.



### Christ as Son and Savior

1 John 4:14

The Father sends the Son as world world Savior. It's a cosmic mission of of redemption.

Colossians 1:13-14

Deliverance comes through the Son.

His blood provides redemption and
forgiveness of sins.

Hebrews 1:2-3

Jesus, as Son, is creator and purifier. purifier. He's the radiance of God's God's glory.



### Confession of Faith

1 1 John 4:15

Confessing Jesus as God's Son ensures divine indwelling. It's a transformative declaration.

2 Ephesians 2:8-9

Salvation comes by grace through faith. It's God's gift, not human human works.

3 Hebrews 10:23

Hold fast to the confession of hope. God's faithfulness undergirds undergirds our perseverance.



### God's Love and Abiding

1 John 4:16

God is love. Abiding in love means abiding in God. It's a reciprocal reciprocal relationship.

Galatians 5:6

Faith works through love. It's the active expression of genuine genuine belief.

Ephesians 3:17-19

Being rooted in love leads to fullness. Comprehending Christ's love surpasses knowledge.

Hebrews 12:5-6

God's love is expressed through discipline. It's a refining, paternal paternal love.



### The Spirit's Empowerment

**Inner Strengthening** 

Ephesians 3:16 highlights the Spirit's role in fortifying believers' inner being.



Spiritual Fruit

Galatians 5:22 lists love as the Spirit's primary fruit. It's a divine character trait.



**Divine Participation** 

Hebrews 6:4 speaks of partaking in the Holy Spirit. It's a mystical communion.

## Christ's Indwelling

Faith Reception

Ephesians 3:17 describes Christ dwelling in hearts through through faith. It's a spiritual reality.

Hopeful Presence

Colossians 1:27 presents "Christ in you" as the hope of of glory. It's transformative.

**Continuing Life** 

Colossians 2:6-7 urges ongoing life in Christ. It's a progressive, deepening relationship.
