1 John 4:14


Father sent Son as world's Savior.

Hebrews 2:9


Jesus tasted death by God's grace for all.

Eternal Life

1 John: God's testimony about eternal life in Son.



Knowing God

Hebrews: Draws near to God through Christ's mediation.



New Covenant

Hebrews: Enables deeper, more intimate knowledge of God.
