Mutual Indwelling: God and Believers

1 Access to God

Hebrews 4:16 encourages believers to approach God's throne of grace with confidence.

2 Entering the Sanctuary

Hebrews 10:19–22 speaks of entering God's presence through Christ's sacrifice.

3 Dwelling Place

Hebrews 3:6 describes believers as God's house, echoing the mutual indwelling concept.





The Holy Spirit's Role

1

Gifts of the Spirit

Hebrews 2:4 mentions the Holy Spirit's role in distributing gifts to believers.

2

Witness to Believers

In Hebrews 10:15, the Holy Spirit testifies to the new covenant's reality.

3

Eternal Spirit

Hebrews 9:14 uniquely refers to the "eternal Spirit" in Christ's sacrifice.

Jesus: Son of God and Savior

Divine Sonship

Hebrews 1:2–3 emphasizes Jesus' role as God's Son and heir of all things.

High Priest

Hebrews 4:14–15 presents Jesus as the great high priest who sympathizes with us.

Ultimate Sacrifice

Hebrews 9:11–14 describes Christ's self-offering as the perfect, eternal sacrifice for sins.



Importance of Confession and Belief

1

Apostle of Our Confession

Hebrews 3:1 refers to Jesus as the apostle of our confession.

2

Holding Fast

Hebrews 10:23 exhorts believers to hold fast to their confession without wavering.

3

Faith's Necessity

Hebrews 11:6 states that without faith, it is impossible to please God.

Hebrews 3:14 links partaking in Christ with holding our original confidence firm to the end.

Drawing Near

Hebrews 7:25 speaks of drawing near to God through Christ's intercession.

Enduring Faith

Hebrews 10:38–39 encourages living by faith, not shrinking back from God.

Unshakeable Kingdom

Hebrews 12:28 describes receiving an unshakeable kingdom, implying permanent dwelling with God.

Promised Rest

Hebrews 4:1-11 describes entering God's eternal rest through faith.



Eternal Inheritance

Hebrews 9:15 speaks of receiving the promised eternal inheritance.



Heavenly City

Hebrews 11:10,16 portrays eternal life as dwelling in God's heavenly city.
